# Finding information on OA publishing in the Search Tool

Collecting Open Access options for different journals can be very time-consuming. The [Lib4RI Search Tool](#) provides the relevant information on a journal level at just one click. This allows you to easily compare journals and find the best one for your manuscript. (Load pictures to view the description or open the web version of this newsletter).
