### ... how you can re-use copyrighted content at no cost?

Sometimes you want to re-use or reproduce copyrighted content for a publication. This may be associated with high costs. However, there is an agreement between STM publishers. STM means science, technology and medicine and covers most of the publishers relevant for us. Choose "Publisher (STM signatory)" rather than "Individual researcher" at your requests, to get gratis permission to re-use up to three figures.
